A BILL

To include cybersecurity technical assistance in the national rural water and wastewater circuit rider program of Department of Agriculture.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Cybersecurity for
5 Rural Water Systems Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. INCLUSION OF CYBERSECURITY TECHNICAL AS-**
2 **SISTANCE IN THE NATIONAL RURAL WATER**
3 **AND WASTEWATER CIRCUIT RIDER PRO-**
4 **GRAM.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 306(a)(22)(A) of the Con-
6 solidated Farm and Rural Development Act (7 U.S.C.
7 1926(a)(22)(A)) is amended—

8 (1) by striking “and” at the end of clause (i);
9 and

10 (2) by redesignating clause (ii) as clause (iii)
11 and inserting after clause (i) the following:

12 “(ii) shall include cybersecurity tech-
13 nical assistance for rural water systems
14 serving fewer than 10,000 persons, to—

15 “(I) assess system efficacy in
16 protecting against cyber threats; and

17 “(II) implement cybersecurity
18 plans, procedures, and technologies to
19 protect against cyber threats; and”.

20 (b) EXTENSION OF PROGRAM.—Section
21 306(a)(22)(B) of such Act (7 U.S.C. 1926(a)(22)(B)) is
22 amended by striking “\$25,000,000 for each of fiscal years
23 2019 through 2023” and inserting “\$32,500,000 for each
24 of fiscal years 2026 through 2030, of which \$7,500,000
25 for each of the fiscal years shall be used to provide cyber-
