A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to improve the ability of veterans to make appointments for mental health care furnished by the Secretary.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Veteran Falls
5 Through the Cracks Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. IMPROVEMENTS TO SCHEDULING BY VETERANS OF**
7 **MENTAL HEALTH APPOINTMENTS AT DE-**
8 **PARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS.**

9 (a) RESCHEDULING CANCELLED APPOINTMENTS.—

10 If a covered veteran cancels an appointment for mental

1 health care furnished by the Secretary of Veterans Affairs,
2 the Secretary shall seek to reschedule the appointment,
3 regardless of the method by which the veteran cancelled
4 the appointment. In seeking to reschedule such appoint-
5 ment, the Secretary shall contact the veteran by telephone.
6 If the veteran does not reschedule the appointment during
7 the first telephone call, the Secretary shall contact the vet-
8 eran at least once more by telephone to reschedule the ap-
9 pointment.

10 (b) COVERED VETERAN DEFINED.—In this section,
11 the term “covered veteran” means a veteran who is en-
12 rolled in the system of patient enrollment established
13 under section 1705(a) of title 38, United States Code.
