## AN ACT

To amend section 102(a)(20) of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 to require the exclusion of service-connected disability compensation when determining whether a person is a person of low and moderate income, a person of low income, or a person of moderate income, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2       This Act may be cited as the “Disabled Veterans  
3 Housing Support Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. SERVICE CONNECTED DISABILITY COMPENSATION.**

5       Section 102(a)(20) of the Housing and Community  
6 Development Act of 1974 (42 U.S.C. 5302(a)(20)) is  
7 amended by adding at the end the following:

8           “(C) SERVICE-CONNECTED DISABILITY COM-  
9 PENSATION.—When determining whether a person is  
10 a person of low and moderate income, a person of  
11 low income, or a person of moderate income under  
12 this paragraph, a State, unit of general local govern-  
13 ment, or Indian tribe shall exclude any service-con-  
14 nected disability compensation received by such per-  
15 son from the Department of Veterans Affairs.”.

16 **SEC. 3. REPORT.**

17       The Comptroller General of the United States shall,  
18 not later than 1 year after the date of the enactment of  
19 this Act, submit to the Congress a report that—

- 20           (1) examines how service-connected disability  
21 compensation is treated for the purposes of deter-  
22 mining eligibility for all programs administered by  
23 the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development;  
24           (2) identifies any instances where service-con-  
25 nected disability compensation is treated in a man-

1       ner inconsistent with the amendment made by sec-  
2       tion 2; and

3           (3) with respect to each program administered  
4       by the Secretary of Housing and Urban Develop-  
5       ment in which service-connected disability compensa-  
6       tion is treated inconsistently, provides legislative rec-  
7       ommendations relating to how such program could  
8       better serve veteran populations, and under-served  
9       communities.
