- 6 States Code, the commemorative work to commemorate
- 7 the commitment and service of the women who worked on
- 8 the home front during World War II authorized by section
- 9 702 of division DD of the Consolidated Appropriations
- 10 Act, 2023 (40 U.S.C. 8903 note; Public Law 117–328),
- 11 may be located within—
- 12 (1) Area I, as depicted on the map entitled
- "Commemorative Areas Washington, DC and Envi-
- 14 rons", numbered 869/86501 B, and dated June 24,
- 15 2003; or
- 16 (2) the Reserve.
- 17 SEC. 3. DEFINITIONS.
- In this Act, the term "Reserve" has the meaning
- 19 given such term in section 8902(a)(3) of title 40, United
- 20 States Code.
