A BILL

To prohibit the use of appropriated funds to eliminate, consolidate, or otherwise restructure any office within the Department of Education that administers or enforces programs under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Protecting Students
5 with Disabilities Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. FINDINGS.**

7 Congress finds the following:

1 (1) Section 1402 of the Individuals with Dis-
2 abilities Education Act explicitly states that the Of-
3 fice of Special Education Programs shall be housed
4 within the Department of Education and tasked with
5 administering and carrying out programs and activi-
6 ties concerning the education of children with dis-
7 abilities.

8 (2) The executive branch does not have the uni-
9 lateral authority to alter this statutory framework.
10 This Act reaffirms Congress’s intent and ensures
11 compliance with existing statute.

12 **SEC. 3. PROHIBITION.**

13 None of the funds made available by Acts making ap-
14 propriations may be used to—

15 (1) eliminate, consolidate, or otherwise restruc-
16 ture any office within the Department of Education
17 that administers or enforces programs under the In-
18 dividuals with Disabilities Education Act (20 U.S.C.
19 1400 et seq.);

20 (2) terminate, reassign, or alter the responsibil-
21 ities of any personnel of any such office; or

22 (3) contract with, or delegate to, any entity out-
23 side of the Department of Education to administer
24 or enforce such programs.

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
