#### AN ACT

- To require the Secretary of Homeland Security to publish on a monthly basis the number of special interest aliens encountered attempting to unlawfully enter the United States, and for other purposes.

#### 1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2	This Act may be cited as the "Special Interest Alien
3	Reporting Act of 2025".
4	SEC. 2. PUBLICATION BY THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND
5	SECURITY OF THE NUMBER OF SPECIAL IN-
6	TEREST ALIENS ENCOUNTERED.
7	(a) In General.—Not later than the seventh day of
8	each month beginning with the first full month that begins
9	after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary
10	of Homeland Security shall publish on a publicly available
11	webpage of the Department of Homeland Security and
12	submit to the Committee on Homeland Security of the
13	House of Representatives and the Committee on Home-
14	land Security and Governmental Affairs of the Senate a
15	report on the total number, and an identification of the
16	nationalities or countries of last habitual residence, of spe-
17	cial interest aliens encountered by the Department during
18	the immediately preceding month. Each such report shall
19	also include the following:
20	(1) Such number disaggregated by geographic
21	regions of such encounters.
22	(2) Specifications relating to whether such en-
23	counters were made at land, air, or sea ports of
24	entry, between ports of entry, or in the interior of

the United States.

1	(3) Identification of any such nationalities or
2	countries of last habitual residence that are covered
3	nations.
4	(b) Inclusion.—The first report required under sub-
5	section (a) shall also include the matters described in such
6	subsection for the time period from January 20, 2021,
7	through January 19, 2025.
8	(c) Definitions.—In this section:
9	(1) Alien.—The term "alien" has the meaning
10	given such term in section 101 of the Immigration
11	and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101).
12	(2) COVERED NATION.—The term "covered na-
13	tion" has the meaning given such term in section
14	4872(f)(2) of title 10, United States Code.
15	(3) Special interest alien.—The term "spe-
16	cial interest alien" means an alien who, based on an
17	analysis of travel patterns, potentially poses a na-
18	tional security risk to the United States or its inter-
19	ests.
