AN ACT

To direct the United States Postal Service to designate single, unique ZIP Codes for certain communities, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SINGLE, UNIQUE ZIP CODES FOR CERTAIN**
2 **COMMUNITIES.**

3 Not later than 270 days after the date of the enact-
4 ment of this Act, the United States Postal Service shall
5 designate a single, unique ZIP Code for each of the fol-
