A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to clarify the jurisdiction and certain rules of evidence of the Board of Veterans' Appeals.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
 2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 *This Act may be cited as the “Protecting Veteran’s*
 5 *Claim Options Act”.*

6 **SEC. 2. BOARD OF VETERANS’ APPEALS: JURISDICTION;**
 7 **EVIDENCE IN CERTAIN CASES.**

8 *(a) JURISDICTION OVER A SUPPLEMENTAL CLAIM.—*
 9 *Section 7104 of title 38, United States Code, is amended,*
 10 *in subsection (a)—*

11 *(1) by inserting “(1)” before “All questions”; and*

12 *(2) by adding at the end the following new para-*
 13 *graph:*

14 *“(2) In an appeal of a decision under section 5108*
 15 *of this title regarding a supplemental claim under section*
 16 *5104C(a)(1)(B) of this title, the Board may not deny relief*
 17 *(including by denying review of the merits of the claim)*
 18 *solely on the basis that the appellant did not present or*
 19 *secure new and relevant evidence with respect to such sup-*
 20 *plemental claim.”.*

21 *(b) EVIDENCE IN CASES REMANDED TO THE BOARD*
 22 *BY THE COURT OF APPEALS FOR VETERANS CLAIMS.—Sec-*
 23 *tion 7113 of title 38, United States Code, is amended by*
 24 *adding at the end the following new subsection:*

1 “(d) *CASES REMANDED BY THE COURT OF APPEALS*
2 *FOR VETERANS CLAIMS.*—(1) *Except as provided in para-*
3 *graph (2), for cases remanded to the Board by the Court*
4 *of Appeals for Veterans Claims, the evidentiary record be-*
5 *fore the Board shall be limited to the evidence previously*
6 *considered by the Board in such case.*

7 “(2) *The evidentiary record before the Board for cases*
8 *described in paragraph (1) shall include evidence submitted*
9 *by the appellant and his or her representative, if any, with-*
10 *in 90 days following such remand, which the Board shall*
11 *consider in the first instance.”.*

12 **SEC. 3. EXTENSION OF CERTAIN LIMITS ON PAYMENTS OF**
13 **PENSION.**

14 *Section 5503(d)(7) of title 38, United States Code, is*
15 *amended by striking “November 30, 2031” and inserting*
16 *“January 30, 2035”.*

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
