Mr. JACKSON of Texas (for himself, Mr. DAVIS of North Carolina, Mr. BACON, Mr. COSTA, Mr. GRAY, Mr. ROUZER, Mr. FINSTAD, and Mr. NEWHOUSE) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Agriculture

A BILL

To amend the Animal Health Protection Act to reauthorize the animal disease prevention and management programs, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Foreign Animal Dis-
5 ease Prevention, Surveillance, and Rapid Response Act of
6 2025”.

1 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF ANIMAL DISEASE PREVEN-**
2 **TIONS AND MANAGEMENT PROGRAMS.**

3 (a) MANDATORY FUNDING.—Section 10409A(d)(1)
4 of the Animal Health Protection Act (7 U.S.C.
5 8308a(d)(1)) is amended to read as follows:

6 “(1) MANDATORY FUNDING.—

7 “(A) FISCAL YEARS 2023 THROUGH 2025.—

8 Of the funds of the Commodity Credit Corpora-
9 tion, the Secretary shall make available to carry
10 out this section \$30,000,000 for each of fiscal
11 years 2023 through 2025, of which not less
12 than \$18,000,000 shall be made available for
13 each of those fiscal years to carry out sub-
14 section (b).

15 “(B) FISCAL YEARS 2026 THROUGH 2029.—

16 Of the funds of the Commodity Credit Corpora-
17 tion, the Secretary shall make available to carry
18 out this section \$233,000,000 for each of fiscal
19 years 2026 through 2029, of which—

20 “(i) not less than \$10,000,000 shall
21 be made available for each such fiscal year
22 to carry out subsection (a);

23 “(ii) not less than \$70,000,000 shall
24 be made available for each such fiscal year
25 to carry out subsection (b); and

1 “(iii) not less than \$153,000,000 shall
 2 be made available for each such fiscal year
 3 to carry out subsection (c).

4 “(C) SUBSEQUENT FISCAL YEARS.—Of the
 5 funds of the Commodity Credit Corporation, the
 6 Secretary shall make available to carry out this
 7 section \$75,000,000 for fiscal year 2031 and
 8 each fiscal year thereafter, of which not less
 9 than \$45,000,000 shall be made available for
 10 each of those fiscal years to carry out sub-
 11 section (b).”.

12 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—

13 (1) NATIONAL ANIMAL HEALTH LABORATORY
 14 NETWORK.—Section 10409A(d)(2)(A) of the Animal
 15 Health Protection Act (7 U.S.C. 8308a(d)(2)(A)) is
 16 amended to read as follows:

17 “(A) NATIONAL ANIMAL HEALTH LABORA-
 18 TORY NETWORK.—In addition to the funds
 19 made available under paragraph (1), there is
 20 authorized to be appropriated to carry out sub-
 21 section (a)—

22 “(i) \$30,000,000 for each of fiscal
 23 years 2019 through 2025; and

24 “(ii) \$45,000,000 for each of fiscal
 25 years 2026 through 2030.”.

1 (2) NATIONAL ANIMAL DISEASE PREPAREDNESS
2 AND RESPONSE PROGRAM; NATIONAL ANIMAL VAC-
3 CINE AND VETERINARY COUNTERMEASURES
4 BANK.—Section 10409A(d)(2)(B) of the Animal
5 Health Protection Act (7 U.S.C. 8308a(d)(2)(B)) is
6 amended by striking “2023” and inserting “2030”.

7 (3) AVAILABILITY AND PURPOSE OF FUND-
8 ING.—Section 10409A(e)(1) of the Animal Health
9 Protection Act (7 U.S.C. 8308a(e)(1)) is amended
10 by striking “2023” and inserting “2030”.

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
