Mr. HARDER of California (for himself and Mr. LAWLER) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce

A BILL

To amend the Public Health Service Act to reauthorize grants for first responder training.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Safer Response Act
5 of 2025”.

6 **SEC. 2. FIRST RESPONDER TRAINING PROGRAM.**

7 Section 546 of the Public Health Service Act (42
8 U.S.C. 290ee–1) is amended—

9 (1) in subsection (a), by striking “tribes and
10 tribal” and inserting “Tribes and Tribal”;

1 (2) in subsections (a), (c), and (d)—

2 (A) by striking “approved or cleared” each
3 place it appears and inserting “approved,
4 cleared, or otherwise legally marketed”; and

5 (B) by striking “opioid” each place it ap-
6 pears;

7 (3) in subsection (f)—

8 (A) by striking “approved or cleared” each
9 place it appears and inserting “approved,
10 cleared, or otherwise legally marketed”;

11 (B) in paragraph (1), by striking “opioid”;

12 (C) in paragraph (2)—

13 (i) by striking “opioid and heroin”
14 and inserting “opioid, heroin, and other
15 drug”; and

16 (ii) by striking “opioid overdose” and
17 inserting “overdose”; and

18 (D) in paragraph (3), by striking “opioid
19 and heroin”; and

20 (4) in subsection (h), by striking “\$36,000,000
21 for each of fiscal years 2019 through 2023” and in-
22 serting “\$57,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2026
23 through 2030”.

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
