A BILL

To transfer administrative jurisdiction of certain Federal land in Saratoga Springs, Utah, from the Secretary of the Interior to the United States Postal Service for construction of a post office, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TRANSFER OF ADMINISTRATIVE JURISDICTION**
4 **OF LAND TO USPS; CONSTRUCTION OF POST**
5 **OFFICE.**

6 (a) TRANSFER.—

1 (1) IN GENERAL.—Administrative jurisdiction
2 of the Federal land is hereby transferred from the
3 Secretary of the Interior to the United States Postal
4 Service for use as a United States Postal facility,
5 consistent with subsection (b).

6 (2) FEDERAL LAND.—For the purposes of this
7 section, the term “Federal land” means the approxi-
8 mately 20.32 acres of Federal land in Saratoga
9 Springs, Utah, known as Parcel #58:022:0021, lo-
10 cated approximately west of Mountain View Corridor
11 and north of SR-73 with access off Wild Blossom
12 Boulevard.

13 (b) CONSTRUCTION OF POST OFFICE.—Not later
14 than 2 years after the date of the enactment of this Act,
15 the Postal Service shall construct and begin operation of
16 a post office on the Federal land transferred to the Postal
17 Service under subsection (a).

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
