Mr. MOORE of West Virginia introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Defense to establish the Faithful Patriot Campaign Medal.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Faithful Patriot Cam-
5 paign Medal Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. FAITHFUL PATRIOT CAMPAIGN MEDAL.**

7 (a) SERVICE MEDAL REQUIRED.—The Secretary of
8 Defense shall design and produce a military service medal,
9 to be known as the “Faithful Patriot Campaign Medal”,
10 to honor members of the Armed Forces and veterans who

1 served on the border of the United States with Mexico in
2 the course of Operation Faithful Patriot or a subsequent
3 operation at such border.

4 (b) DISTRIBUTION OF MEDAL.—

5 (1) ISSUANCE TO RETIRED AND FORMER MEM-
6 BERS.—At the request of an individual described in
7 subsection (a), the Secretary of Defense shall issue
8 the Faithful Patriot Campaign Medal to such indi-
9 vidual.

10 (2) ISSUANCE TO NEXT-OF-KIN.—In the case of
11 an individual described in subsection (a) who is de-
12 ceased, the Secretary may provide for issuance of
13 the Faithful Patriot Campaign Medal to the next-of-
14 kin of the individual.

15 (3) APPLICATION.—The Secretary shall prepare
16 and disseminate as appropriate an application by
17 which individuals described in subsection (a) and
18 their next-of-kin may apply to receive the Faithful
19 Patriot Campaign Medal.

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
