A BILL

To direct the United States International Trade Commission to carry out a study on the inflationary impact of the tariffs imposed by certain Executive orders and to report to Congress the findings of such study.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Toll of Tariffs Act
5 of 2025”.

1 **SEC. 2. UNITED STATES INTERNATIONAL TRADE COMMIS-**
2 **SION STUDY AND REPORT ON INFLATIONARY**
3 **EFFECTS OF TARIFFS.**

4 (a) STUDY.—The United States International Trade
5 Commission (in this Act referred to as the “Commission”)
6 shall carry out a study on the inflationary impact of the
7 tariffs imposed by Executive orders issued during the pe-
8 riod beginning on or after January 20, 2025, and ending
9 on the date of enactment of this Act.

10 (b) REPORT.—Not later than 60 days after the date
11 of enactment of this Act, the Commission shall submit to
12 Congress a report containing—

13 (1) the results of the study under subsection
14 (a); and

15 (2) impacts to the Consumer Price Index for
16 All Urban Consumers (CPI–U) and in comparable
17 measures tracking price changes in non-urban areas,
18 as determined by the Bureau of Labor Statistics, of
19 the tariffs described in subsection (a).

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
