A BILL

To amend the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968 to
reauthorize the National Flood Insurance Program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 *This Act may be cited as the “NFIP Extension Act*
5 *of 2026”.*

6 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF THE NATIONAL FLOOD INSURANCE**
7 **PROGRAM.**

8 (a) *FINANCING.*—Section 1309(a) of the National
9 *Flood Insurance Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 4016(a)) is amend-*
10 *ed by striking “September 30, 2023” and inserting “Sep-*
11 *tember 30, 2026”.*

12 (b) *PROGRAM EXPIRATION.*—Section 1319 of the Na-
13 *tional Flood Insurance Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 4026) is*
14 *amended by striking “September 30, 2023” and inserting*
15 *“September 30, 2026”.*

16 (c) *RETROACTIVE EFFECTIVE DATE.*—*If this Act is en-*
17 *acted after January 30, 2026, the amendments made by*
18 *subsections (a) and (b) shall take effect as if enacted on*
19 *January 30, 2026.*

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
