A BILL

To amend title 49, United States Code, to grant the United States Virgin Islands and Puerto Rico eligibility to issue commercial driver’s licenses, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. APPLICATION OF COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHI-**
4 **CLE SAFETY.**

5 (a) DEFINITIONS.—Section 31301(14) of title 49,
6 United States Code, is amended—

7 (1) by striking “and” and inserting a comma;

8 and

1 (2) by inserting “, and the United States Virgin
2 Islands and Puerto Rico” before the period.

3 (b) PENALTY.—Section 165(c) of title 49, United
4 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
5 lowing:

6 “(8) PENALTY.—The amounts treated as being
7 apportioned to the United States Virgin Islands
8 under this subsection shall be deemed to be required
9 to be apportioned to the United States Virgin Is-
10 lands under that section for purposes of the imposi-
11 tion of any penalty under this title or title 49.”.

12 (c) IMPLEMENTATION.—The Administrator of the
13 Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration shall work
14 with the United States Virgin Islands and Puerto Rico on
15 obtaining full compliance with chapter 313 of title 49,
16 United States Code, and regulations adopted under such
17 chapter.

18 (d) GRACE PERIOD.—Notwithstanding section
19 31311(a) of title 49, United States Code, during a 5-year
20 period beginning on the date of enactment of this Act, the
21 United States Virgin Islands and Puerto Rico shall not
22 be subject to a withholding of an apportionment of funds
23 under paragraphs (1) and (2) of section 104(b) of title
24 23, United States Code, for failure to comply with any

1 requirement under section 31311(a) of title 49, United
2 States Code.
