A BILL

To amend the Safe Drinking Water Act to provide grants under the Drinking Water Infrastructure Risk and Resilience Program for training programs relating to protecting public water systems from and responding to cyberattacks, and for other purposes.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Water Cybersecurity
5 Enhancement Act of 2025”.

1 **SEC. 2. COMMUNITY WATER SYSTEM RISK AND RESIL-**
2 **IENCE.**

3 Section 1433(g) of the Safe Drinking Water Act (42
4 U.S.C. 300i-2(g)) is amended—

5 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “2020 and
6 2021” and inserting “2026 through 2031”;

7 (2) in paragraph (2), by striking subparagraph
8 (F) and inserting the following:

9 “(F) participation in training programs,
10 and the purchase of training manuals and guid-
11 ance materials, relating to security and resil-
12 ience, including—

13 “(i) protecting community water sys-
14 tems from cyberattacks; and

15 “(ii) responding to cyberattacks;”;

16 and

17 (3) in paragraph (6), by striking “2020 and
18 2021” and inserting “2026 through 2031”.

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
