A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Health and Human Services to extend the annual open enrollment period for enrolling in a qualified health plan offered by an Exchange for plan year 2026.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Right to Enroll Act
5 of 2025”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENDING ANNUAL OPEN ENROLLMENT PERIOD**
2 **FOR EXCHANGES FOR PLAN YEAR 2026.**

3 The Secretary of Health and Human Services shall
4 revise section 155.410(e) of title 45, Code of Federal Reg-
5 ulations (or any successor regulation) to provide that the
6 annual open enrollment period determined for plan year
7 2026 pursuant to section 1311(c)(6) of the Patient Pro-
8 tection and Affordable Care Act (42 U.S.C. 18031(c)(6))
9 shall begin on November 1, 2025, and end on May 1,
10 2026.
