A BILL

To amend title XI of the Social Security Act to require the Secretary to exclude certain individuals and entities who commit fraud from participation in any Federal health care program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. MAKING CERTAIN EXCLUSIONS FROM PARTICI-**
2 **PATION IN FEDERAL HEALTH CARE PRO-**
3 **GRAMS RELATED TO FRAUD MANDATORY.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1128 of the Social Secu-
5 rity Act (42 U.S.C. 1320a–7) is amended—

6 (1) in subsection (a), by adding at the end the
7 following new paragraphs:

8 “(5) CONVICTION RELATING TO FRAUD.—Any
9 individual or entity that has been convicted for an
10 offense which occurred on or after the date that is
11 1 year after the date of the enactment of this para-
12 graph, under Federal or State law—

13 “(A) of a criminal offense consisting of a
14 misdemeanor relating to fraud, theft, embezzle-
15 ment, breach of fiduciary responsibility, or
16 other financial misconduct—

17 “(i) in connection with the delivery of
18 a health care item or service, or

19 “(ii) with respect to any act or omis-
20 sion in a health care program (other than
21 those specifically described in paragraph
22 (1)) operated by or financed in whole or in
23 part by any Federal, State, or local govern-
24 ment agency; or

25 “(B) of a criminal offense relating to
26 fraud, theft, embezzlement, breach of fiduciary

1 responsibility, or other financial misconduct
 2 with respect to any act or omission in a pro-
 3 gram (other than a health care program) oper-
 4 ated by or financed in whole or in part by any
 5 Federal, State, or local government agency.

6 “(6) FRAUD, KICKBACKS, AND OTHER PROHIB-
 7 ITED ACTIVITIES.—Any individual or entity that the
 8 Secretary determines has committed an act which is
 9 described in section 1128A, 1128B, or 1129 on or
 10 after the date that is 1 year after the date of the
 11 enactment of this paragraph.”;

12 (2) in subsection (b)—

13 (A) in paragraph (1), by inserting “and
 14 before the date that is 1 year after the date of
 15 the enactment of subsection (a)(5)” before “,
 16 under Federal or State law”; and

17 (B) in paragraph (7), by inserting “before
 18 the date that is 1 year after the date of the en-
 19 actment of subsection (a)(6)” before the period
 20 at the end; and

21 (3) in subsection (f)(2), by inserting “(a)(6) or”
 22 after “subsection” each place it appears.

23 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section
 24 1128D(a)(1)(A)(ii) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
 25 1320a–7d(a)(1)(A)(ii)) is amended by striking “section

1 1128(b)(7)” and inserting “subsection (a)(6) or (b)(7) of
2 section 1128”.
