To amend the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008 to increase food access for recipients of supplemental nutrition assistance program benefits by permitting the use of benefits to pay the related cost of food delivery services.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Snap Delivery Mod-
5 ernization Act of 2025”.

6 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS.**

7 The Food and Nutrition Act of 2008 (7 U.S.C. 2011
8 et seq.) is amended—

1 (1) in section 3 by adding the following defini-
2 tion—

3 “(X) ‘Delivery platform or delivery services
4 provider’ means an entity that—

5 “(1) facilitates the online-sale, or delivery, or
6 both, of food from a retail food store; or

7 “(2) delivers food purchased from a retail food
8 store, including using a first-party delivery service or
9 contracting with a third-party to complete delivery.”.

10 (2) in section 3(o)(5)—

11 (A) in subparagraph (B)—

12 (i) by striking “order—” and all that
13 follows through “(i)”, and

14 (ii) by striking clause (ii), and

15 (B) in subparagraph (C) by inserting “(ex-
16 cluding related fees for delivery of the food)”
17 before the period at the end, and

18 (3) in section 7(k)—

19 (A) in subparagraph (2)(B)—

20 (i) by striking “delivery,”, and

21 (ii) by inserting “(excluding delivery
22 fees charged by the retail food store or a
23 delivery platform or delivery service)” after
24 “charges”, and

25 (B) in subparagraph (C)(i)—

- 1 (i) by striking “delivery,” and
- 2 (ii) by inserting “(excluding delivery
- 3 fees charged by a retail food store, or a de-
- 4 livery platform or delivery service)” after
- 5 “purchase”.
