Mr. GOLDEN of Maine submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2550) to nullify the Executive order relating to Exclusions from Federal Labor-Management Relations Programs, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That immediately upon adoption of this res-
2 olution, the House shall proceed to the consideration in
3 the House of the bill (H.R. 2550) to nullify the Executive
4 order relating to Exclusions from Federal Labor-Manage-
5 ment Relations Programs, and for other purposes. All
6 points of order against consideration of the bill are waived.
7 The bill shall be considered as read. All points of order
8 against provisions in the bill are waived. The previous

1 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and on
2 any amendment thereto to final passage without inter-
3 vening motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally di-
4 vided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority
5 member of the Committee on Oversight and Government
6 Reform or their respective designees; and (2) one motion
7 to recommit.

8 SEC. 2. Clause 1(c) of rule XIX and clause 8 of rule
9 XX shall not apply to the consideration of H.R. 2550.

10 SEC. 3. The Clerk shall transmit to the Senate a mes-
11 sage that the House has passed H.R. 2550 no later than
12 one week after passage.
