3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Improving Access to
5 Addiction Medicine Providers Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. MINORITY FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM.**

7 Section 597 of the Public Health Service Act (42
8 U.S.C. 2901l) is amended—

- 1 (1) in subsection (a)(1), by inserting “diag-
- 2 nosis,” after “related to”; and
- 3 (2) in subsection (b), by inserting “addiction
- 4 medicine,” after “psychiatry.”
