1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- This Act may be cited as the "Preventing Child Traf-

- 4 SEC. 2. DEFINED TERM.
- 5 In this Act, the term "anti-trafficking recommenda-
- 6 tions" means the recommendations set forth in the report
- 7 of the Government Accountability Office entitled "Child
- 8 Trafficking: Addressing Challenges to Public Awareness
- 9 and Survivor Support", which was published on December
- 10 11, 2023.
- 11 SEC. 3. CONTINUED IMPLEMENTATION OF ANTI-TRAF-
- 12 FICKING PROGRAMS FOR CHILDREN.
- 13 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Office for Victims of Crime
- 14 of the Department of Justice, in coordination with the Of-
- 15 fice on Trafficking in Persons of the Administration for
- 16 Children and Families, shall continue implementing the
- 17 anti-trafficking recommendations by—
- 18 (1) working together, in accordance with the
- 19 leading collaboration practices referenced in GAO-
- 20 24–106038, to develop and implement strategies to
- 21 prevent child trafficking and support child traf-
- ficking survivors; and
- 23 (2) establishing achievable performance goals
- and targets for anti-trafficking programs for chil-
- dren that reflect leading practices, such as being ob-

- 1 jective, measurable, and quantifiable, using baseline
- 2 data from program grantees.
- 3 (b) Report.—Not later than 180 days after the date
- 4 of the enactment of this Act, the Director of the Office
- 5 for Victims of Crime shall submit a report to the Com-
- 6 mittee on the Judiciary of the Senate and Committee on
- 7 the Judiciary of the House of Representatives that explic-
- 8 itly describes the steps taken pursuant to subsection (a).
