AN ACT

To adjust the boundary of Big Bend National Park in the State of Texas, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- This Act may be cited as the "Big Bend National
- 3 Park Boundary Adjustment Act".
- 4 SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.
- 5 In this Act:
- 6 (1) Map.—The term "map" means the map en-
- 7 titled "Big Bend National Park, Proposed Boundary
- 8 Adjustment", numbered 155/167,296, and dated
- 9 November 2022.
- 10 (2) PARK.—The term "Park" means the Big
- Bend National Park established under the Act of
- 12 June 20, 1935 (49 Stat. 393, chapter 283; 16
- 13 U.S.C. 156).
- 14 (3) Secretary.—The term "Secretary" means
- 15 the Secretary of the Interior.
- 16 SEC. 3. BIG BEND NATIONAL PARK BOUNDARY ADJUST-
- 17 MENT.
- 18 (a) Land Acquisition.—The Secretary may acquire
- 19 approximately 6,100 acres of land or interests in land gen-
- 20 erally depicted on the map as "Tracts to Include in
- 21 Boundary" by donation or exchange.
- (b) AVAILABILITY OF MAP.—The map shall be on file
- 23 and available for public inspection in the appropriate of-
- 24 fices of the National Park Service.

1	(c) Boundary Revision and Administration.—
2	On acquisition of any land or interests in land under sub-
3	section (a), the Secretary shall—
4	(1) revise the boundary of the Park to include
5	the acquired land or interests in land; and
6	(2) administer the acquired land or interests in
7	land as part of the Park in accordance with applica-
8	ble laws (including regulations).
9	(d) Eminent Domain or Condemnation.—In car-
10	rying out this Act, the Secretary may not use eminent do-
11	main or condemnation.
