A BILL

To require the Director of the United States Fish and Wildlife Service to reissue a final rule removing the gray wolf from the list of endangered and threatened wildlife under the Endangered Species Act of 1973.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REISSUANCE OF RULE REMOVING THE GRAY**
4 **WOLF FROM THE LIST OF ENDANGERED AND**
5 **THREATENED WILDLIFE.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 60 days after the
7 date of enactment of this Act, the Director of the United
8 States Fish and Wildlife Service shall reissue the final rule

5 (b) NO JUDICIAL REVIEW.—Reissuance of the final
6 rule described in subsection (a) shall not be subject to ju-
7 dicial review.

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
