A BILL

To rescind an amount appropriated to the United States Agency for International Development and appropriate such amount to the Department of Veterans Affairs for the construction of State homes for veterans.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Veterans First Act
5 of 2025”.

1 **SEC. 2. FUNDING FOR GRANTS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF**
2 **STATE HOMES FOR VETERANS.**

3 (a) RESCISSION.—From the unobligated balance of
4 amounts made available to the United States Agency for
5 International Development, \$2,000,000,000 is hereby per-
6 manently rescinded.

7 (b) APPROPRIATION.—There is appropriated to the
8 Department of Veterans Affairs \$2,000,000,000 for
9 grants to assist States to acquire or construct State nurs-
10 ing home and domiciliary facilities and to remodel, modify,
11 or alter existing hospital, nursing home, and domiciliary
12 facilities in State homes for purposes of furnishing care
13 to veterans, as authorized by sections 8131 through 8138
14 of title 38, United States Code, to remain available until
15 expended.

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
