Mr. WICKER (for himself and Ms. CANTWELL) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Commerce, Science, and Transportation

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## A BILL

To reauthorize the Integrated Coastal and Ocean Observation System Act of 2009, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Integrated Ocean Ob-  
5 servation System Reauthorization Act of 2025”.

6 **SEC. 2. PURPOSES.**

7 Section 12302 of the Integrated Coastal and Ocean  
8 Observation System Act of 2009 (33 U.S.C. 3601) is  
9 amended—

1 (1) in paragraph (1), in the matter preceding  
2 subparagraph (A)—

3 (A) by striking “Council” and inserting  
4 “Committee”;

5 (B) by striking “and ocean observation”  
6 and inserting “, ocean, and meteorological ob-  
7 servations”; and

8 (C) by striking “and coastal information”  
9 and inserting “, coastal, and meteorological in-  
10 formation”; and

11 (2) in paragraph (4)(A), by inserting “data  
12 management systems and cyber infrastructure,”  
13 after “data gaps,”.

14 **SEC. 3. DEFINITIONS.**

15 Section 12303 of the Integrated Coastal and Ocean  
16 Observation System Act of 2009 (33 U.S.C. 3602) is  
17 amended—

18 (1) in paragraph (2)—

19 (A) in the paragraph heading, by striking  
20 “Council” and inserting “Committee”; and

21 (B) by striking “term” and all that follows  
22 through “established” and inserting “term  
23 ‘Committee’ means the Ocean Policy Committee  
24 established”;

1           (2) in paragraph (3), by striking “Council” and  
2           inserting “Committee”;

3           (3) in paragraph (6), by inserting “conduct  
4           operational oceanography measurements and” after  
5           “systems in order to”;

6           (4) by redesignating paragraphs (8) and (9) as  
7           paragraphs (9) and (10), respectively;

8           (5) by inserting after paragraph (7) the fol-  
9           lowing:

10           “(8) STATE.—The term ‘State’ has the mean-  
11           ing given that term in section 3501 of title 40,  
12           United States Code.”; and

13           (6) in paragraph (10), as redesignated by para-  
14           graph (4), by striking “Council” and inserting  
15           “Committee”.

16 **SEC. 4. INTEGRATED COASTAL AND OCEAN OBSERVING**  
17 **SYSTEM.**

18           Section 12304 of the Integrated Coastal and Ocean  
19           Observation System Act of 2009 (33 U.S.C. 3603) is  
20           amended—

21           (1) in subsection (b)(1)—

22                   (A) in subparagraph (A), by striking “na-  
23                   tional” and inserting “regional, national,”;

24                   (B) in subparagraph (C), by inserting  
25                   “and ocean” after “weather”; and

1 (C) in subparagraph (E)—

2 (i) in clause (iv), by inserting “and  
3 ocean” after “weather” each place it ap-  
4 pears; and

5 (ii) in clause (v), by inserting “and  
6 ocean” after “weather”;

7 (2) in subsection (c)—

8 (A) in paragraph (1)—

9 (i) in the paragraph heading, by strik-  
10 ing “COUNCIL” and inserting “COM-  
11 MITTEE”; and

12 (ii) in the matter preceding subpara-  
13 graph (A), by striking “Council” each  
14 place it appears and inserting “Com-  
15 mittee”;

16 (B) in paragraph (2)—

17 (i) in subparagraph (A), by striking  
18 “The Council” and inserting “The Com-  
19 mittee”; and

20 (ii) in subparagraph (B)—

21 (I) by redesignating clauses (vi)  
22 through (x) as clauses (vii) through  
23 (xi), respectively; and

24 (II) by inserting after clause (v)  
25 the following:

- 1 “(vi) develop requirements and proc-  
2 esses for regional associations and feder-  
3 ally funded projects of the agencies partici-  
4 pating in the Interagency Ocean Observa-  
5 tion Committee to collaborate with the re-  
6 gional coastal observing systems for data  
7 sharing at regional levels;” and  
8 (C) in paragraph (3)(C)—  
9 (i) in clause (iii)(I), by inserting “as  
10 operational entities” after “associations”;  
11 (ii) in clause (x), by inserting “, cyber  
12 infrastructure,” after “data management”;  
13 and  
14 (iii) in clause (xiii)—  
15 (I) by inserting “and ocean”  
16 after “weather”; and  
17 (II) by striking “and harmful  
18 algal bloom forecasting” and inserting  
19 “harmful algal bloom forecasting, and  
20 resource and coastal management”;  
21 (3) in subsection (d)(1), by adding a period at  
22 the end; and  
23 (4) by striking “the Council” each place it ap-  
24 pears and inserting “the Committee”.

1 **SEC. 5. REPORT TO CONGRESS.**

2 Section 12307 of the Integrated Coastal and Ocean  
3 Observation System Act of 2009 (33 U.S.C. 3606) is  
4 amended—

5 (1) in subsection (b)—

6 (A) by redesignating paragraphs (8) and  
7 (9) as paragraphs (9) and (10), respectively;  
8 and

9 (B) by inserting after paragraph (7) the  
10 following:

11 “(8) a post-storm evaluation for all major  
12 storms in the United States that occurred during  
13 the year preceding submission of the report, to as-  
14 sess the impact of observations of the System and  
15 other products of the System with respect to storm  
16 forecast accuracy;” and

17 (2) by striking “the Council” each place it ap-  
18 pears and inserting “the Committee”.

19 **SEC. 6. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

20 Section 12311 of the Integrated Coastal and Ocean  
21 Observation System Act of 2009 (33 U.S.C. 3610) is  
22 amended—

23 (1) by striking “There are” and inserting the  
24 following:

25 “(a) IN GENERAL.—There are”;

1           (2) by striking “this subtitle” and all that fol-  
2           lows and inserting “\$56,000,000 for each of fiscal  
3           years 2026 through 2030.”; and

4           (3) by adding at the end the following:

5           “(b) ALLOCATION OF FUNDS.—

6           “(1) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided by  
7           paragraph (2), the Secretary shall allocate not less  
8           than 7.5 percent of amounts appropriated pursuant  
9           to the authorization of appropriations under sub-  
10          section (a) to each regional coastal observing system  
11          that was in existence on January 1, 2025.

12          “(2) EXCLUSION OF DISASTER RELIEF APPRO-  
13          PRIATIONS.—Paragraph (1) does not apply with re-  
14          spect to any amounts appropriated by an Act mak-  
15          ing supplemental appropriations for disaster relief.”.

16 **SEC. 7. CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.**

17          (a) INTERAGENCY FINANCING AND AGREEMENTS.—  
18          Section 12305(b) of the Integrated Coastal and Ocean Ob-  
19          servation System Act of 2009 (33 U.S.C. 3604(b)) is  
20          amended by striking “the Council” and inserting “the  
21          Committee”.

22          (b) PUBLIC-PRIVATE USE POLICY.—Section 12308  
23          of the Integrated Coastal and Ocean Observation System  
24          Act of 2009 (33 U.S.C. 3607) is amended by striking “the

1 Council” each place it appears and inserting “the Com-  
2 mittee”.

3 (c) INTENT OF CONGRESS.—Section 12310 of the In-  
4 tegrated Coastal and Ocean Observation System Act of  
5 2009 (33 U.S.C. 3609) is amended by striking “the Coun-  
6 cil” each place it appears and inserting “the Committee”.

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
