and Mr. TUBERVILLE) introduced the following bill; which was read twice
and referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To amend the mission statement of the United States Military Academy to include the phrase “Duty, Honor, Country”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Maintaining Academy
5 Culture and Assuring Retention of Tradition, Honor, and
6 Unity of the Republic Act (MACARTHUR) Act”.

7 **SEC. 2. SENSE OF CONGRESS.**

8 It is the sense of Congress that the principles of
9 “Duty, Honor, Country” should be—

- 1 (1) deeply embedded in the ethos of the United
2 States Military Academy; and
3 (2) instilled in each cadet.

4 **SEC. 3. MODIFICATION OF UNITED STATES MILITARY**
5 **ACADEMY MISSION STATEMENT.**

6 Not later than 30 days after the date of the enact-
7 ment of this Act, the Secretary of the Army shall amend
8 the mission statement of the United States Military Acad-
9 emy to include the phrase “Duty, Honor, Country”.

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
