A BILL

To amend the Taiwan Allies International Protection and Enhancement Initiative (TAIPEI) Act of 2019 to provide that the United States, in its role as a member of any international organizations, should oppose any attempts by the People's Republic of China to resolve Taiwan's status by distorting the decisions, language, policies, or procedures of any such organization, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Taiwan International
3 Solidarity Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. CLARIFICATION REGARDING UNITED NATIONS GEN-**
5 **ERAL ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION 2758 (XXVI).**

6 Section 2(a) of the Taiwan Allies International Pro-
7 tection and Enhancement Initiative (TAIPEI) Act of 2019
8 (Public Law 116–135) is amended—

9 (1) in the matter preceding paragraph (1), by
10 striking “(a) FINDINGS.—”; and

11 (2) by adding at the end the following:

12 “(10) United Nations General Assembly Reso-
13 lution 2758 (XXVI) established the representatives
14 of the Government of the People’s Republic of China
15 as the only lawful representatives of China to the
16 United Nations. The resolution did not address the
17 issue of representation of Taiwan and its people in
18 the United Nations or any related organizations, nor
19 did the resolution take a position on the relationship
20 between the People’s Republic of China and Taiwan
21 or include any statement pertaining to Taiwan’s sov-
22 ereignty.

23 “(11) The United States opposes any initiative
24 that seeks to change Taiwan’s status without the
25 consent of the people of Taiwan.”.

1 **SEC. 3. UNITED STATES ADVOCACY FOR INTERNATIONAL**
2 **ORGANIZATIONS TO RESIST THE PEOPLE'S**
3 **REPUBLIC OF CHINA'S EFFORTS TO DISTORT**
4 **THE "ONE CHINA" POSITION.**

5 Section 4 of the Taiwan Allies International Protec-
6 tion and Enhancement Initiative (TAIPEI) Act of 2019
7 is amended—

8 (1) in paragraph (2), by striking “and” at the
9 end;

10 (2) in paragraph (3), by striking the period at
11 the end and inserting “; and”; and

12 (3) by adding at the end the following:

13 “(4) to instruct, as appropriate, representatives
14 of the United States Government in all organizations
15 described in paragraph (1) to use the voice, vote,
16 and influence of the United States to advocate that
17 such organizations resist the People’s Republic of
18 China’s efforts to distort the decisions, language,
19 policies, or procedures of such organizations regard-
20 ing Taiwan.”.

21 **SEC. 4. OPPOSING THE PEOPLE’S REPUBLIC OF CHINA’S**
22 **EFFORTS TO UNDERMINE TAIWAN’S TIES AND**
23 **PARTNERSHIPS INTERNATIONALLY.**

24 Section 5(a) of the Taiwan Allies International Pro-
25 tection and Enhancement Initiative (TAIPEI) Act of 2019
26 is amended—

1 (1) in paragraph (2), by striking “and” at the
2 end;

3 (2) in paragraph (3), by striking the period at
4 the end and inserting “; and”; and

5 (3) by adding at the end the following:

6 “(4) encourage, as appropriate, United States
7 allies and partners to oppose the People’s Republic
8 of China’s efforts to undermine Taiwan’s official
9 diplomatic relationships and its partnerships with
10 countries with which it does not maintain diplomatic
11 relations.”.

12 **SEC. 5. REPORT ON THE PEOPLE’S REPUBLIC OF CHINA’S**
13 **ATTEMPTS TO PROMOTE ITS “ONE CHINA”**
14 **POSITION.**

15 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 5(b) of the Taiwan Allies
16 International Protection and Enhancement Initiative
17 (TAIPEI) Act of 2019 is amended by inserting before the
18 period at the end the following: “and information relating
19 to any prior or ongoing attempts by the People’s Republic
20 of China to undermine Taiwan’s membership or observer
21 status in all organizations described in section 4(1) and
22 Taiwan’s ties and relationships with other countries in ac-
23 cordance with subsection (a)”.

24 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
25 subsection (a) shall—

1 (1) take effect on the date of the enactment of
2 this Act; and

3 (2) apply beginning with the first report re-
4 quired after such date under section 5(b) of the Tai-
5 wan Allies International Protection and Enhance-
6 ment Initiative (TAIPEI) Act of 2019, as amended
7 by subsection (a).

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
