A BILL

To deny pretrial release for certain individuals, and for other
purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Bail Post-Jail
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. DENIAL FOR PRETRIAL RELEASE FOR PRIOR IN-**
7 **CARCERATION.**

8 Section 3124(e) of title 18, United States Code is
9 amended by adding at the end the following:

10 “(4) A person shall be considered to pose a
11 danger to the safety of the community and be ineli-

1 gible for release if the judicial officer finds that the
2 person—

3 “(A) is charged with a felony offense;

4 “(B) is an adult or a juvenile charged as
5 an adult with regard to the offense; and

6 “(C) has a prior felony conviction for a
7 crime of violence that resulted in the person
8 serving not less than 30 days in a State or Fed-
9 eral correctional facility, not including any pe-
10 riod of pretrial detention without conviction.”.

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
