A BILL

To restrict United States voluntary and assessed contributions to the United Nations, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Stop Funding Global
5 Terrorists Act of 2025”.

6 **SEC. 2. RESTRICTION ON FUNDING FOR UNITED NATIONS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—The United States may not make
8 any voluntary or assessed contributions to the United Na-
9 tions for assistance in Afghanistan until the Secretary of

1 State certifies to the appropriate congressional committees
2 that—

3 (1) no United States funds are used in cash
4 shipments by the United Nations into Afghanistan;

5 (2) no specially designated global terrorist orga-
6 nization receives funds as a result of such cash ship-
7 ments; and

8 (3) no foreign terrorist organization receives
9 funds as a result of such cash shipments.

10 (b) REVOCATION.—If, after making a certification
11 pursuant to subsection (a), the Secretary determines that
12 such certification is inaccurate, the Secretary shall—

13 (1) revoke such certification; and

14 (2) provide to the appropriate congressional
15 committees—

16 (A) a notification of such revocation; and

17 (B) a detailed justification for such revoca-
18 tion.

19 (c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

20 (1) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMIT-
21 TEES.—The term “appropriate congressional com-
22 mittees” means—

23 (A) Committee on Foreign Relations and
24 the Committee on Appropriations of the Senate;
25 and

1 (B) Committee on Foreign Affairs and the
2 Committee on Appropriations of the House of
3 Representatives.

4 (2) FOREIGN TERRORIST ORGANIZATION.—The
5 term “foreign terrorist organization” means an or-
6 ganization that has been designated as a foreign ter-
7 rorist organization by the Secretary of State, pursu-
8 ant to section 219 of the Immigration and Nation-
9 ality Act (8 U.S.C. 1189).

10 (3) SPECIALLY DESIGNATED GLOBAL TER-
11 RORIST ORGANIZATION.—The term “specially des-
12 ignated global terrorist organization” means an or-
13 ganization that has been designated as a specially
14 designated global terrorist pursuant to Executive
15 Order 13224 (50 U.S.C. 1701 note; relating to
16 blocking property and prohibiting transactions with
17 persons who commit, threaten to commit, or support
18 terrorism).

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
