A BILL

To repeal section 213 of division C of the Continuing Appropriations, Agriculture, Legislative Branch, Military Construction and Veterans Affairs, and Extensions Act, 2026.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Anti-Cash Grab Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPEAL.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 213 of division C of the
3 Continuing Appropriations, Agriculture, Legislative
4 Branch, Military Construction and Veterans Affairs, and
5 Extensions Act, 2026 (Public Law 119–37) is repealed,
6 and section 10 of the Legislative Branch Appropriations
7 Act, 2005 (2 U.S.C. 6628) is restored as if such section
8 213 had not been enacted.

9 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
10 subsection (a) shall take effect as if included in the enact-
11 ment of division C of the Continuing Appropriations, Agri-
12 culture, Legislative Branch, Military Construction and
13 Veterans Affairs, and Extensions Act, 2026 (Public Law
14 119–37).

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
