A BILL

To amend the Federal Lands Recreation Enhancement Act to provide for a free annual National Parks and Federal Recreational Lands Pass for law enforcement officers and firefighters.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Law Enforcement Offi-
5 cer and Firefighter Recreation Pass Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. NATIONAL RECREATIONAL PASSES FOR LAW EN-**
 2 **FORCEMENT OFFICERS AND FIREFIGHTERS.**

3 Section 805(b) of the Federal Lands Recreation En-
 4 hancement Act (16 U.S.C. 6804(b)) is amended by strik-
 5 ing paragraph (3) and inserting the following:

6 “(3) ANNUAL PASSES.—

7 “(A) DEFINITIONS.—In this paragraph:

8 “(i) FIREFIGHTER.—The term ‘fire-
 9 fighter’ means any employee of the Federal
 10 Government, a State, a unit of local gov-
 11 ernment, or an Indian Tribe who performs
 12 work directly related to suppressing fires,
 13 including wildland fires.

14 “(ii) LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER.—
 15 The term ‘law enforcement officer’ means
 16 any officer, agent, or employee of the Fed-
 17 eral Government, a State, a unit of local
 18 government, or an Indian Tribe who is—

19 “(I) authorized by law or by a
 20 government agency to engage in or
 21 supervise the prevention, detection, or
 22 investigation of any violation of crimi-
 23 nal law; or

24 “(II) authorized by law to super-
 25 vise sentenced criminal offenders.

1 “(B) AVAILABILITY.—The Secretary shall
2 make the National Parks and Federal Rec-
3 reational Lands Pass available, at no cost, to
4 each member of the Armed Forces and their de-
5 pendents, and each law enforcement officer or
6 firefighter, who provides adequate proof of eligi-
7 bility for such pass, as determined by the Sec-
8 retary.”.

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
