1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- This Act may be cited as the "Network Equipment
- 3 Transparency Act" or the "NET Act".
- 4 SEC. 2. TELECOMMUNICATIONS SUPPLY CHAIN CONSIDER-
- 5 ATION.
- 6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 13(b) of the Communica-
- 7 tions Act of 1934 (47 U.S.C. 163(b)) is amended—
- 8 (1) by redesignating paragraphs (3), (4), and
- 9 (5) as paragraphs (4), (5), and (6), respectively; and
- 10 (2) by inserting after paragraph (2) the fol-
- 11 lowing:
- "(3) assess, to the extent that data is available
- to the Commission, how the availability of network
- 14 equipment may have impacted the deployment of ad-
- vanced telecommunications capability during the ap-
- 16 plicable reporting period;".
- 17 (b) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in the
- 18 amendments made by subsection (a) shall be construed to
- 19 require any provider of advanced telecommunications ca-
- 20 pability to provide the Federal Communications Commis-
- 21 sion more information than was required for the purpose
- 22 of section 13 of the Communications Act of 1934 (47
- 23 U.S.C. 163) as in effect on the day before the date of
- 24 enactment of this Act.
