### **AN ACT**

To amend title 36, United States Code, to revise the Federal charter for the Foundation of the Federal Bar Association.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

#### 1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 2 This Act may be cited as the "Foundation of the Fed-
- 3 eral Bar Association Charter Amendments Act of 2025".
- 4 SEC. 2. ORGANIZATION.
- 5 Section 70501 of title 36, United States Code, is
- 6 amended—
- 7 (1) by striking subsection (b); and
- 8 (2) by redesignating subsection (c) as sub-
- 9 section (b).
- 10 SEC. 3. MEMBERSHIP.
- 11 Section 70503 of title 36, United States Code, is
- 12 amended—
- (1) by striking subsections (a) and (b) and in-
- serting the following:
- 15 "(a) Eligibility.—Except as provided in this chap-
- 16 ter, eligibility for membership in the corporation and the
- 17 rights and privileges of members are as provided in the
- 18 bylaws."; and
- 19 (2) by redesignating subsection (c) as sub-
- section (b).
- 21 SEC. 4. GOVERNING BODY.
- Section 70504 of title 36, United States Code, is
- 23 amended to read as follows:
- 24 "§ **70504.** Governing body
- 25 "(a) Board of Directors.—The board of directors
- 26 is the governing body of the corporation. The board may

- 1 exercise, or provide for the exercise of, the powers of the
- 2 corporation. The board of directors and the responsibilities
- 3 of the board are as provided in the bylaws.
- 4 "(b) Officers.—The officers and the election of the
- 5 officers are as provided for in the bylaws.".
- 6 SEC. 5. RESTRICTIONS.
- 7 Section 70507 of title 36, United States Code, is
- 8 amended to read as follows:
- 9 "§ **70507. Restrictions**
- 10 "(a) STOCK AND DIVIDENDS.—The corporation may
- 11 not issue stock or declare or pay a dividend.
- 12 "(b) Political Activities.—
- 13 "(1) IN GENERAL.—The activities, funds, in-
- come, and property of the corporation may not be
- used to carry on political activity or attempt to in-
- 16 fluence legislation.
- 17 "(2) No contribution, support, or partici-
- 18 PATION.—The corporation or a director or officer in
- 19 the corporate capacity of the director of officer may
- 20 not contribute to, support, or participate in any po-
- 21 litical activity or in any manner attempt to influence
- legislation.
- "(c) Distribution of Income or Assets.—
- 24 "(1) In general.—The income or assets of the
- corporation may not inure to the benefit of, or be

1	distributed to, a director, officer, or member during				
2	the life of the charter granted by this chapter. This				
3	subsection does not prevent the payment, in				
4	amounts approved by the board of directors, of—				
5	"(A) reasonable compensation; or				
6	"(B) reimbursement for expenses incurred				
7	in undertaking the corporation's business, to of				
8	ficers, directors, or members.				
9	"(2) Rule of construction.—This sub-				
10	section shall not be construed to—				
11	"(A) prevent the award of a grant to				
12	Federal Bar Association chapter of which an of				
13	ficer, director, or member may be a member; o				
14	"(B) prevent the payment of reasonable				
15	compensation to the corporation's employees for				
16	services undertaken on behalf of the corpora				
17	tion.				
18	"(d) Loans.—The corporation may not make a loan				
19	to a director, officer, member, or employee.				
20	"(e) Immunity From Liability.—Members and pr				
21	vate individuals are not liable for the obligations of th				
22	corporation.				
23	"(f) Claim of Governmental Approval or Au				
24	THORITY.—The corporation—				

- 5 "(1) may not claim congressional approval or 1 2 the authority of the United States Government for 3 any of its activities; and "(2) may acknowledge this charter.". 4 SEC. 6. PRINCIPAL OFFICE. 6 Section 70508 of title 36, United States Code, is amended by striking "the District of Columbia," and inserting "a United States location decided by the board of 8 directors and specified in the bylaws,". SEC. 7. SERVICE OF PROCESS. 11 Section 70510 of title 36, United States Code, is 12 amended to read as follows: "§ 70510. Service of process "The corporation shall comply with the law on service

- 15 of process of the State or District in which it is incor-
- 16 porated.".
- SEC. 8. DEPOSIT OF ASSETS ON DISSOLUTION OR FINAL
- 18 LIQUIDATION.
- 19 Section 70512 of title 36, United States Code, is
- 20 amended to read as follows:
- 21 "§ 70512. Deposit of assets on dissolution or final liq-
- 22 uidation
- "On dissolution or final liquidation of the corpora-23
- tion, any assets of the corporation remaining after the dis-
- charge of all liabilities shall be distributed—

- 1 "(a) as provided by the board of directors; and
- 2 "(b) in compliance with the charter and bylaws.".

#### 3 SEC. 9. DETERMINATION OF BUDGETARY EFFECTS.

- 4 The budgetary effects of this Act, for the purpose of
- 5 complying with the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of 2010,
- 6 shall be determined by reference to the latest statement
- 7 titled "Budgetary Effects of PAYGO Legislation" for this
- 8 Act, submitted for printing in the Congressional Record
- 9 by the Chairman of the Senate Budget Committee, pro-
- 10 vided that such statement has been submitted prior to the
- 11 vote on passage.
