

Tyson Slocum is director of Public Citizen's Energy Program, covering the regulation of petroleum, natural gas and power markets. Tyson serves on the U.S. Commodity Futures Trading Commission's Energy & Environmental Markets Advisory Committee, and the CFTC's Market Risk Advisory Committee, and is an active intervenor before the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission representing the interests of households and the public interest. Tyson is active before the U.S. Department of Energy intervening and commenting on proceedings involving the exportation of natural gas. Tyson presents his research in congressional testimony and appears regularly in the media, including appearances on Fox News, CNN, MSNBC and The Colbert Report. Tyson is a member of the faculty at the University of Maryland, where he teaches an Honors College seminar on energy and climate policy, and was named Teacher Of The Year in 2017.
