3	(a) In General.—Chapter 448 of title 49, United
4	States Code, is further amended by adding at the end the

8	"(a) In General.—Subject to applicable State law
9	relating to the discharge of a firearm, an individual may
10	shoot an unmanned aircraft using a legally-obtained shot-
11	gun if the individual reasonably believes that such aircraft
12	is flying not more than 200 feet above property owned
13	by the individual.
14	"(b) Return of Aircraft.—An individual may, but
15	shall not be required to, return an unmanned aircraft shot
16	down under subsection (a) to the owner of such aircraft
17	upon request by such owner.
18	"(c) Reporting.—Not later than 60 days after an
19	event in which an individual shoots an unmanned aircraft

- 2 tion number of such aircraft, the individual shall report

- 5 "(1) the address at which such event occurred;

- 8 "(d) REGULATIONS.—The Administrator shall issue

- 10 "(e) Definition of Shotgun.—In this section, the
- 11 term 'shotgun' has the meaning given such term in section
- 12 921 of title 18, United States Code.
- 13 "(f) Rule of Construction.—Nothing in this sec-
- 14 tion shall be construed to preempt or otherwise have any
- 15 effect on any State law relating to tort liability or criminal
- 16 liability for an action taken under subsection (a).".
- 17 (b) Clerical Amendment.—The analysis for chap-
