8	"SEC. 124. REQUIREMENT FOR CERTAIN WORKFORCE MAN-

0	"(a) Analysis Required.—Within 7 days of taking
1	a covered action, the head of an element of the intelligence
2	community, in consultation with the Director of National
3	Intelligence, shall submit to the congressional intelligence
4	committees an analysis of the impact of the covered action
5	on the mission of such element. Such analysis shall in-
6	clude—
7	"(1) a description of the covered action;
8	"(2) an analysis of the capability of such ele-
9	ment after the covered action is carried out to—

1	"(A) collect, analyze, and disseminate in-
2	telligence information to policymakers in ac-
3	cordance with the National Intelligence Strat-
4	egy required under section 108A; and
5	"(B) fulfill statutorily-required functions of
6	such element;
7	"(3) a description of any counterintelligence
8	concerns associated with the covered action;
9	"(4) a counterintelligence mitigation strategy to
10	address such concerns;
11	"(5) a description of the anticipated costs and
12	benefits of the covered action and the goals of the
13	covered action; and
14	"(6) an identification of the statutory authority
15 _.	to carry out the covered action.
16	"(b) COVERED ACTION.—In this section, the term
17	'covered action' means an action that involves or is likely
18	to involve the separation of—
19	"(1) 50 or more employees of an element of the
20	intelligence community; or
21	"(2) 5 percent or more of the total number of
22	employees of such element.".
