1 SEC. 3. ACCEPTANCE BY HOUSE AND SENATE.

2	(a) Acceptance.—For purposes of determining
3	whether the Chairman of the Council of the District of
4	Columbia has transmitted an Act to Congress pursuant
5	to section 602(e) of the District of Columbia Home Rule
6	Act (sec. 1–206.02(c), D.C. Official Code) or has sub-
7	mitted an Act to Congress pursuant to section 303 of such
8	Act (sec. 1–203.03, D.C. Official Code), the House of Rep-
9	resentatives and Senate shall treat such an Act which the
10	Chairman transmits or submits in electronic form in the
11	same manner as an Act which the Chairman submits in
12	paper form.
13	(b) Exercise of Rulemaking Authority.—This
14	section is enacted by Congress—
15	(1) as an exercise of the rulemaking power of
16	the Senate and House of Representatives, respec-
17	tively, and as such is deemed a part of the rules of
18	each House, respectively, but applicable only with re-
19	spect to the procedure to be followed in that House
20	in the case of Acts described in subsection (a), and
21	supersede other rules only to the extent that it is in-
22	consistent with such rules; and
23	(2) with full recognition of the constitutional
24	right of either House to change the rules (so far as
25	relating to the procedure of that House) at any time,
