Re: Hearing titled "From Protection to Persecution: EPA Enforcement Gone Rogue Under the Biden Administration"

On Tuesday, September 16, 2025, at 1:00 PM ET in room 2247 of the Rayburn House Office Building, the Subcommittee on Federal Law Enforcement will host a hearing titled "From Protection to Persecution: EPA Enforcement Gone Rogue Under the Biden Administration."

I. BACKGROUND:

The Biden Administration extensively expanded consent decrees to impose burdensome requirements on American businesses. Small business owners faced aggressive enforcement tactics like federal raids for relatively minor alleged violations, while being coerced into costly consent decrees that threatened their livelihoods. The Trump Administration halted this EPA overreach, but existing Biden-era consent decrees continue to impose harmful financial burdens on businesses across the country.

II. HEARING PURPOSE:

This hearing will examine the Biden Administration's environmental enforcement and assess the ongoing harm caused by Biden-era consent decrees that continue to burden small businesses.
