George Lowe is the Vice President of Governmental Affairs and Public Policy at the American Gas Association (AGA), where he has been at the forefront of shaping energy policy since February 2012. With over a decade of legislative expertise, George has established himself as a visionary leader and strategic innovator, navigating the intricacies of the legislative and regulatory landscapes and spearheading initiatives that drive long-term growth for the natural gas sector.
