**Re: Hearing on “Oversight of Fraud and Misuse of Federal Funds in Minnesota: Part I”**

On Wednesday, January 7, 2026, at 10:00 a.m. in room HVC-210 of the U.S. Capitol Visitor Center, the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform will host a hearing on “Oversight of Fraud and Misuse of Federal Funds in Minnesota: Part I.”

**I. BACKGROUND:**

Recent reporting has brought to national attention a disturbing pattern of long-term, widespread fraud in Minnesota’s state Medicaid programs and the Feeding Our Future school meal distribution initiative. To date, the U.S Department of Justice has charged nearly 100 individuals in connection to these fraudulent schemes. Federal prosecutors have identified as much as \$9 billion in potential fraud and reports indicate that a portion of those funds may have been diverted to international terrorist networks.

**II. HEARING PURPOSE:**

This hearing will examine reports and allegations of widespread fraud revealed in Feeding Our Future and Minnesota’s state Medicaid programs that have occurred under the watch of Governor Tim Walz and Attorney General Keith Ellison. During the hearing, three Minnesota State Representatives will discuss their oversight and investigative work concerning state-managed programs that serve vulnerable populations and receive federal funds.
