Mr. FENTON, from the Committee on Revolutionary Claims, reported the following bill:

A BILL

For the relief of the legal representatives of John Moshier.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the Secretary of the Treasury be, and he is hereby,
4 authorized and required to pay, out of any money in the
5 treasury not otherwise appropriated, to the legal representa-
6 tives of Lieutenant John Moshier, of the eighth Massachusetts
7 regiment in the revolutionary war, or to the heirs of said
8 Moshier, five years' full pay as lieutenant in said war, the
9 same being the commutation for half-pay for life.
