
IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

Mr. GRIDER, from the Committee on Revolutionary Claims, reported the following bill:

A BILL

For the relief of the legal heirs and representatives of Captain John Montjoy, deceased, an officer in the army of the revolution.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the proper accounting officers of the treasury be, and
4 they are hereby, authorized and directed to adjust the claim
5 and account of Captain John Montjoy, an officer in the revo-
6 lutionary army, for his half pay as captain from the day of
7 the disbandment of said army of the revolution until the day
8 of his death, in the
9 and to pay the same to his heirs and legal representatives, to
10 wit: Elizabeth Grigg, Margaret Colier, and Maria Lawson,
11 in equal proportions, or to the joint or separate representatives
12 or lawfully authorized attorney, out of any money in the
13 treasury not otherwise appropriated.
