Mr. McJUNKIN, on leave, introduced the following bill :

**A BILL**

For the relief of Elizabeth Harding.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3       That the Secretary of the Treasury be, and he is hereby,  
4       authorized to pay to Elizabeth Harding, out of any money  
5       not otherwise appropriated, the sum of ten thousand dollars  
6       for services of her son, Jasper Harding, who died in a rebel  
7       prison while in the service of the United States, leaving her  
8       in a dependent condition, all of which is more fully stated  
9       and shown by the papers now on file with the Pension  
10      Committee.
