For the relief of Doctor Alonso Portuondo.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That, for the purposes of the Immigration and Nationality Act, Doctor Alonso Portuondo shall be held and considered to have been lawfully admitted to the United States for permanent residence as of October 26, 1960.

For the relief of Doctor Jacobo Albo Maya.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That, for the purposes of the Immigration and Nationality Act, Doctor Jacobo Albo Maya shall be held and considered to have been lawfully admitted to the United States for permanent residence as of June 19, 1961.

AN ACT

For the relief of Doctor Argyrios A. Tsifutis.

October 3, 1966
[S. 2626]

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That, for the purposes of the Immigration and Nationality Act, Doctor Argyrios A. Tsifutis shall be held and considered to have been lawfully admitted to the United States for permanent residence as of June 25, 1956, and the periods of time that the said Doctor Argyrios A. Tsifutis has resided in the United States since that time shall be held and considered to meet the residence and physical presence requirements of section 316 of the Immigration and Nationality Act.

AN ACT

For the relief of Delma S. Pozas.

October 4, 1966
[S. 146]

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That, in the administration of the Immigration and Nationality Act, Delma S. Pozas may be classified as a child within the meaning of section 101(b) (1) (F) of that Act, and a petition may be filed in behalf of the said Delma S. Pozas by Mr. and Mrs. Luis Guevarra, citizens of the United States, pursuant to section 204 of the Immigration and Nationality Act subject to all the conditions in that section relating to orphans.
