Public Law 94–516 94th Congress

An Act

To name the Federal office building in Bluefield, West Virginia, the "Elizabeth Kee Federal Building".

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That the Federal office building located at 601 Federal Street, Bluefield, West Virginia, is hereby designated as the "Elizabeth Kee Federal Building". Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document, record, or other paper of the United States to such building shall be held to be a reference to the "Elizabeth Kee Federal Building".
