To designate the Federal Building-United States Courthouse in Sacramento, California, the "John E. Moss Federal Building-United States Courthouse".

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That the Federal Building-United States Courthouse, 650 Capitol Mall, Sacramento, California, shall hereafter be known and designated as the "John E. Moss Federal Building-United States Courthouse". Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document, record, or other paper of the United States to such building shall be held to be a reference to the "John E. Moss Federal Building-United States Courthouse".

Approved December 18, 1980.

Sec. 2. Section 804 of the National Weather Modification Policy Act of 1976 (16 U.S.C. 3804) is amended to read as follows: "There are authorized to be appropriated \$150,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1977; \$200,000 each for the fiscal years 1978 through 1980; and \$100,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1981, to carry out the provisions of this chapter."
