Joint Resolution

Aug. 21, 1984  
[H.J. Res. 574]

To designate the week beginning on September 9, 1984, as "National Community Leadership Week".

Whereas local communities form the foundation of our Nation; Whereas qualified and well-trained leadership of our local communities helps sustain our democratic institutions;

Whereas, throughout local communities in the United States, community leadership programs have been instituted to identify and train citizens for leadership positions in their communities; and Whereas hundreds of community leadership programs have produced thousands of talented and well-trained local leaders who are aware of the unique problems confronting their communities and can propose solutions to such problems: Now, therefore, be it

*Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled*, That the week beginning on September 9, 1984, is designated as "National Community Leadership Week", and the President is authorized and requested to issue a proclamation calling upon local communities and the people of the United States to observe such week with appropriate ceremonies and activities.
