## Committee Meetings

### VA-HUD APPROPRIATIONS

*Committee on Rules:* Granted, by voice vote, a rule waiving all points of order against the conference report on H.R. 2099, making appropriations for the Departments of Veterans Affairs and Housing and Urban Development, and for sundry independent agencies, boards, commissions, corporations, and offices for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1996; and against its consideration. The rule further provides that if the conference report is adopted, then a motion that the House insist on its disagreement to Senate amendment 63 shall be considered as adopted. Testimony was heard from Representative Lewis of California.

### BALANCED BUDGET RECONCILIATION ACT

*Committee on Rules:* Granted, by voice vote, a rule providing for taking from the Speaker's table without intervening point of order H.R. 2491, to provide for reconciliation pursuant to section 105 of the con-

current resolution on the budget for fiscal year 1996; with the Senate amendment thereto. The rule provides for the consideration of a motion by the Budget Committee chairman to concur in the Senate amendment. The motion and the amendment are considered as read. The rule provides one hour of debate on the motion divided between the proponent and an opponent. The previous question is considered ordered to final adoption without intervening motion.
