### Chamber Action

**Measures Introduced:** Six bills were introduced, as follows: S. 342-347. **Page S1470**

**Measures Reported:** Reports were made as follows: Special Report entitled "Report on Legislative Activities of the Committee on Labor and Human Resources During the 104th Congress." (S. Rept. No. 105-5) **Page S1470**

**Population Planning:** Senate began consideration of H.J. Res. 36, approving the Presidential finding that the limitation on obligations imposed by section 518A(a) of the Foreign Operations Export Financing, and Related Programs Appropriations Act of 1997, is having a negative impact on the proper functioning of the population planning program. **Pages S1433-48**

Senate will resume consideration of the resolution on Tuesday, February 25, 1997, with a vote to occur thereon at 2:15 p.m.

**Balanced Budget Constitutional Amendment:** Senate resumed consideration of S.J. Res. 1, proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States to require a balanced budget, taking action on amendments proposed thereto, as follows: **Pages S1448-68**

**Rejected:** Byrd Modified Amendment No. 6, to strike the reliance on estimates and receipts. (By 61 yeas to 34 nays (Vote No. 12), Senate tabled the amendment.) **Pages S1448-59**

**Pending:** Reid Amendment No. 8, to require that the outlay and receipt totals of the Federal Old-Age and Survivors Insurance and the Federal Disability Insurance Trust Funds not be included as a part of the budget totals. **Pages S1459-68**

Senate will continue consideration of the resolution on Tuesday, February 25, 1997.
